## **No shortcuts, no easy answers.....**

With your help, last year The Children's Village impacted the lives of more than 11,000 at-risk children and their families, from New York City to the Hudson Valley and on special projects as far away as Iraq and the Netherlands.

The caliber of our work over the past 12 months has again earned us a place as a semi-finalist in the New York Nonprofit Excellence Awards. I am especially gratified by these ongoing recognitions by our peers in light of the dramatic changes in child welfare and juvenile justice and, indeed, in the shifts happening in our own philosophy and work.

As we have done for over 162 years, we continue to provide high quality residential care to teens experiencing acute behavioral and mental health crises. But, we did not stop there. With this change, we have seen better outcomes for children, greater reinvestment of dollars in the communities that need it most, and, of course, a lower financial cost to society.

### Living His Dream

### “There Are Better Boys Out There”

Last year, CV had the highest score among New York City agencies for finding children permanent homes. We are proud of that accomplishment, but unfortunately, not every case works out. When that happens, it is heartbreaking for everyone. Our therapists use all the tools they can to help children deal with disappointment, including our therapy dogs. The following is an account of how a therapist broke the news to 9-year-old Jason that his adoption might not work out.



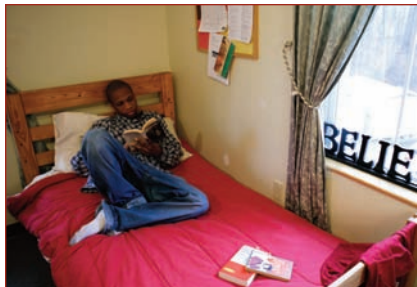
“As I broke the news to Jason, Ruthie (therapy dog) snuggled and nurtured him. We sat amongst my pile of stuffed animals and pillows until, with Ruthie by his side, he drifted off to sleep. He stirred a bit as he slept--whimpering, checking to ensure I was still there, etc.”

This wasn't the first time Jason felt rejection. First his mom left him, then his aunt, then a foster family, and now the possibility of a real family slipped away. Jason rarely gets his hopes up. In fact, the first time he met the couple who wanted to adopt him, he said, “You might want to keep looking. There are better boys out there.”

We are working hard to find a loving family for Jason and feel confident that he will soon have someone to call Mom and/or Dad. In the meantime, he spends a lot of time cuddling with Ruthie.

## Social Impact

CV operates 28 separate programs in more than a dozen locations. For every one of them, we work hard to track and measure the impact we have had on the people we serve. Following are some of the outcomes we achieved in 2013.



### Teens Avoid Foster Care – Saving \$13.26 million!

When teens are at risk of harm to themselves or others and removing them from their homes seems the only solution, we step in. Our Preventive Program helps families get their children on track before serious trouble starts.

Last year, 94% of teens in this program, all of whom were at risk of removal, remained at home and not one in our Manhattan Program was removed during the six months after the program. This success came from engaging the entire family in learning and practicing skills to support each other.

*Savings calculation: Residential program cost = \$130,000/year. Prevention program = \$8,000/year. Assumption: 75% (a conservative estimate) of the 136 families served would have a youth removed without the program (102 youth).  $102 \times \$130,000 = \$13.26$  million. This does not include future savings by avoiding incarceration, food assistance, public health care, and other social services.*

### Homeless Teens Become Independent—Saving \$489,000+

Homelessness can take a decade to overcome, and the emotional distress and shame can be debilitating. CV's Supported Housing program provides homeless teens not just a place to live, but also the life skills and emotional support needed to live independently for a lifetime.



Last year, 21 of the 25 teens in CV's program, all of whom came to us from the streets, left to independent housing. They left with a job, money in a savings account, a support network, and some are working toward a college degree.

*Savings calculation: Average lifetime cost of homelessness = \$69,000. Cost of program = \$21,000. Assumption: at least half of the 21 teens would have sunk into periodic homelessness.  $\$48,000 \times 10.5$  teens = \$489,000 in shelter costs plus savings in social services over a lifetime.*

## Children Find Permanent Families – Saving \$1.15 million!

Adoptions mean family, and family means having people who will love you through mistakes and setbacks. Too often, children enter foster care and languish there year after year with their connections to family slipping away.

Last year, CV met 100% of its adoption goal, with 36 adoptions. In addition, CV had the highest rating in New York City for finding permanent families for children either through adoption or reunification with families.

*Savings calculation: One year of foster care = \$32,000. Finding 36 children permanent families saved \$1,152,000 in just one year. Many children who enter foster care stay several years.*



### More Outcomes:

- ❑ 87% of foster youth in our Bridges to Health Program remained at home
- ❑ 87% of youth on probation in our Harlem Justice Program avoided re-arrest
- ❑ 96% of youth in our Preventive Program remained at home
- ❑ 99% of youth in our Rockland homeless shelter went to a stable home
- ❑ 100% of youth in our Westchester Sanctuary shelter went to a stable home
- ❑ 88% of older youth living on their own in our WAY Home aftercare program were in stable housing
- ❑ 75% of youth in our WAY Home aftercare program graduated high school or are still in school with passing grades
- ❑ 100% of seniors in our Work Force Investment program got their high school diploma, and 93% who were out of school got a GED or work credential

## **Fundraising**

With your help, The Children's Village raised \$2.3 million from private individuals, foundations, and corporations in fiscal year 2013. In addition to private dollars, The Village also raised \$1.35 million in competitive government grants to start new programs or enhance existing ones.

The total cost of fundraising was \$341,400, for a cost as a percentage of funds raised of 9.6%. That means that more than 90 cents out of every dollar raised supports programs and operations. Thank you!

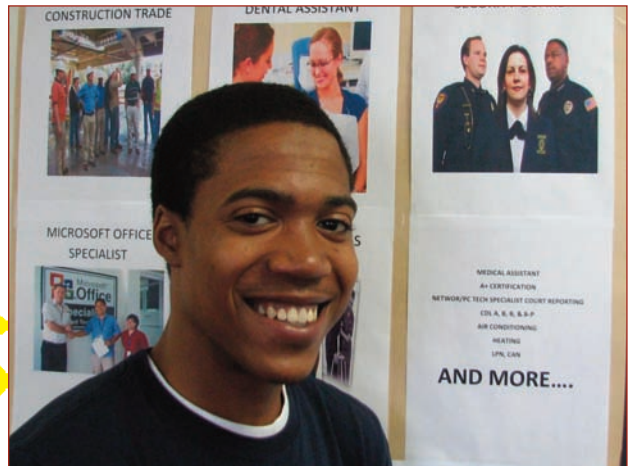
