



Outcome Corner - The WAY Home

A report published recently by The Center for an Urban Future entitled “Fostering Careers” concluded that “An alarming number of foster youth essentially go from being minor wards of the state to adult wards of the state.” CV’s WAY Home program helps foster care youth leaving CV’s residential school beat those odds by providing a paid professional mentor to help them complete school, get and keep a job, and remain in a stable home. Below are outcomes on WAY Home participants compared to those published in the report on former foster care youth.


High School Graduate or Enrolled in School
