



# Letter from our Chair and President

Dear Friend,

This has been another incredible year at The Children's Village, and we are filled with pride in what we've accomplished. We've made a lasting impact on the lives of children, youth, and families across our communities.

Every step forward is thanks to the dedication of our team and the steadfast support of caring people like you. We are excited to share some of our highlights from this year.

- **Global Learning:** In April, nine youth embarked on a life-changing journey to Montserrat. They engaged in hands-on service learning and thoughtful reflection, which enriched their understanding of the African diaspora and the strength found in resilience. This powerful experience fostered profound personal growth and a lasting sense of belonging—insights that will inspire and shape future international learning opportunities at CV.
- **Building Beautiful, Affordable Homes:** We continued to redefine attractive and multi-use developments with affordable homes by prioritizing location, quality, and opportunity. In Inwood, Manhattan, we formally opened The Eliza. The 174 homes are occupied, the New York Public Library, our community center, and Emma's' Torch Teaching Kitchen, co-located at The Eliza are buzzing with activity. In Peekskill, we've laid the groundwork to redevelop a historic property into 22 affordable homes—10 reserved for youth—and 10,000 sq. ft. of commercial space, with a rooftop garden. Additionally, in the Bronx, we are building 123 homes with our partner Urban Pathways. These projects are expected to begin in 2026.
- **Empowering Youth:** Through High School Graduation and Teen Choice – In June, we celebrated the high school graduation of 136 students. For many, reaching this milestone was a challenge, but they made it. Our Inwood House Teen Choice Program engaged 47 senior students across three schools, with 21 attending Brooklyn Academy. Notably, this year's valedictorian and salutatorian, both of whom are two-year peer leaders, received partial college scholarships. 7 are heading to college, 10 to trade school, and 4 have entered the workforce. These outcomes reflect our ongoing commitment to empowering youth through education and providing pathways to success.

These stories are just a glimpse of how we're creating brighter futures—by advancing education, expanding access to quality housing, and strengthening community bonds.

Thank you for standing with us. Your partnership makes this vital work possible, and we are deeply grateful to continue building a better future together in the coming year.

## Ryan's Journey: Foster Care to a Future Abroad

Ryan has always marched to the beat of his own drum—he's curious, self-motivated, and ambitious. That independent spirit has carried him a long way.

This spring, he graduated from high school with peers who had also beaten the odds. "Graduating with everyone made me feel special," he said. "It's great to connect with people who've shared my experiences. I know I'll stay in touch with them."

Ryan excelled in school and sports, competing in volleyball and track. Eager to explore, he traveled abroad for the first time with other CV youth to Montserrat. This trip earned him his first passport, sparked his love of travel, and broadened his worldview.

With Montserrat as a starting point, he is preparing for his next big adventure: a semester abroad in Spain, where he'll study before beginning his coursework at the University of Connecticut. "It was an opportunity I couldn't refuse," he says of the program. "It's going to be a great experience."

Ryan never lets obstacles define him. At age 16, he connected with The Children's Village Family Foster Care Program after several moves between foster homes. Despite struggles, he stayed focused on his goals.

A pivotal moment in Ryan's journey was joining the Working Alongside Youth (WAY) program at The Children's Village. There, he found not just resources, but genuine encouragement and a supportive community. With the guidance of dedicated staff, Ryan confidently navigated the college application process, secured scholarships, and mapped out a clear vision for his future beyond high school.

As Ryan steps into this exciting new chapter of his life, he reminds us that with the right support and unwavering determination, even the most difficult beginnings can lead to incredible destinations – sometimes, across continents.

## Gyselle Reclaims Her Story—and Finds Her Voice

After years in foster care, Gyselle, now 20, fought hard for her independence—now she has her own apartment and steady job. Along the way, she learned to share her story as both a youth advocate and published author.

“It’s not just about speaking up once or twice—it’s about being persistent. Find the right people to talk to, be relentless, and don’t stop until you get the help you need. That’s how I got to where I am today,” she said.

Three years ago, after a decade in the child welfare system, Gyselle was referred to a CV temporary shelter. This opened doors to new opportunities. There, she joined a trauma-informed program with group therapy for youth at risk of trafficking, beginning her emotional healing.

Through group therapy and mentoring, she processed her experiences and started sharing with others. With a new sense of purpose, she reconnected with her mother, graduated high school, and found an apartment and job in the Bronx.

“Getting my own apartment was a turning point,” Gyselle reflected. “That’s when I made the decision to really get involved in advocacy.”

With this new chapter in her life, Gyselle wrote her narrative—literally.

She later published her story in *The Bronx Writes Back: Cradle to Prison Pipeline*, sharing her journey from abuse to advocacy.

Today, Gyselle is a powerful youth advocate. She uses her voice on panels with organizations like The Children’s Village and New York City’s Administration for Child Services to share her experiences and drive change. Through her advocacy, she helps shape policies that support young people.

The Sanctuary served more than 300 youth in 2024 through homes, shelter, and outreach services.



## A New Chapter at The Eliza

At The Eliza, our housing initiative exemplifies a proof of concept that reimagines multi-use developments with affordable housing. Instead of concentrating developments in traditionally segregated or underserved neighborhoods, we are focused on ensuring families live in vibrant, diverse communities that offer the same opportunities and quality of life we would want for ourselves. Our approach centers on creating integrated, attractive, and multi-use developments with affordable homes that are well-connected to public transit, schools, parks, and essential services.

For longtime Harlem resident Marsha, moving into The Eliza this past April brought a long-awaited sense of stability. After many challenges, she and her two teenage granddaughters, ages 14 and 17, were excited to have a place to call home.

"We'd been moving around so much in just two years. I'm so glad we finally have our own apartment."

The Eliza offers more than just housing. For Marsha she enjoys the on-site laundry, access to the fitness room, and a beautiful roof-deck, and the convenience of being near transportation, shops, and a public library.

"I love the neighborhood, the building, and the amenities," she said. "I love my apartment. This really feels like home."

Her new residence also provides the foundation for her role as caregiver. A retired professional who spent more than 20 years supporting students with special needs in NYC schools, she also worked in afterschool programs and foster care.

From 1997 to 2015, she fostered dozens of children, many of whom still stay in touch. "If a child wasn't happy, it bothered me," she said. "That's why I became a foster mom."

At The Eliza, she has begun building new community ties, meeting neighbors and reconnecting with former foster children who now visit her there. "It's a small world," she said. "I didn't even know one of my foster sons was already coming to this building to see friends before I moved in."

Marsha is the realization that this proof of concept is viable. The Eliza stands as a testament to what's possible when the city, private philanthropists, and community partners join forces to tackle the urgent need for a mixed-use development with affordable homes and essential community resources for all residents.






